Slow Loading Times

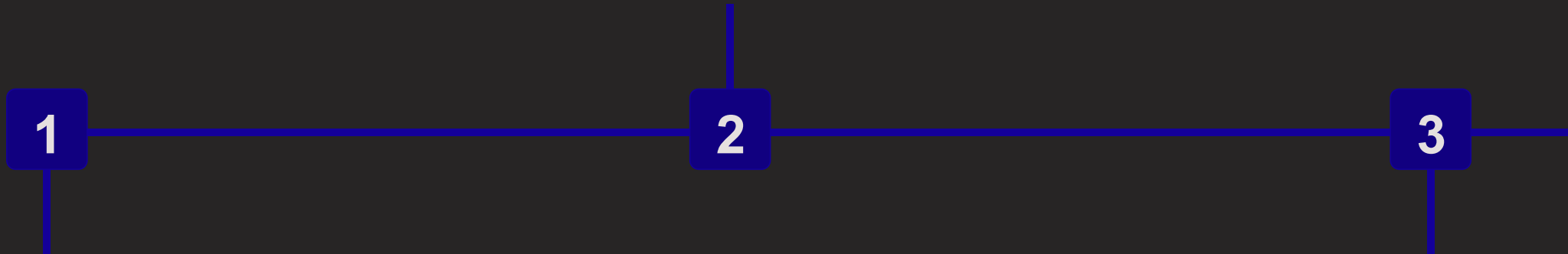
If your device takes too long to load files and apps, it's time to consider upgrading.

2 Better Camera Quality

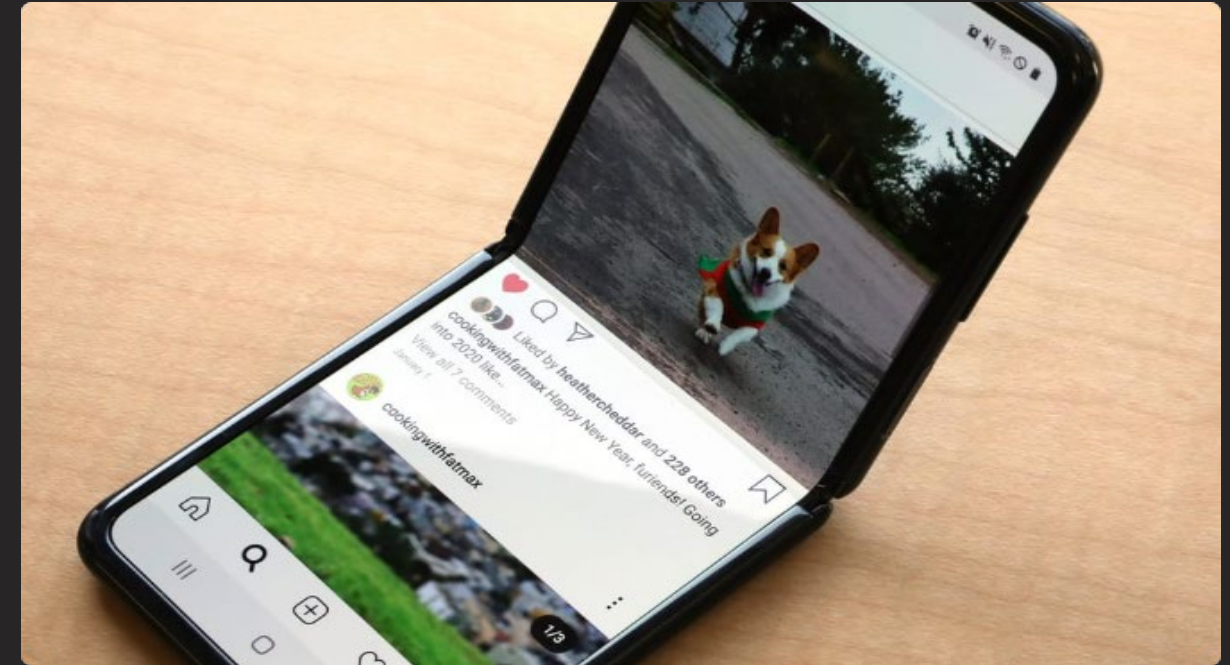
