Setting Up Emergency Contacts and Medical Info on Android



- 1. Open Settings
- 2. Search for Safety and Emergency
- 3. Tap Medical Info select Edit
- 4. Enter Info
- 5. Tap Back Button to Safety & Emergency
- 6. Tap Emergency Contacts
- 7. Select or Search for Contact
- 8. Tap Plus Sign

Setting Up Emergency Contacts and Medical Info on iPhone



- 1. Open the Health app
- 2. Tap your profile picture
- 3. Tap Medical ID
- 4. Edit Medical ID
- 5. Add Emergency Contacts and Medical Info Scroll down to the Emergency Contacts section and tap the green plus button to add an emergency contact. You can also add your medical information by scrolling down to the Medical Information section and tapping the green plus button.

Accessing Your Medical Information







Setup your phone's Medical ID with important health information, such as known allergies, medical conditions, medications, and blood type.



Bypassing Phone Lock

First responders can access your Medical ID from the Lock Screen even if your phone is locked with a passcode or Touch ID.



View from Medical Staff

Medical professionals can view your Medical ID from their device by connecting it to yours using NFC or scanning a QR code.

Providing Information

Emergency contacts can provide information to first responders about any medical conditions, allergies, or medications you may have.

Notifying Loved Ones

Emergency contacts can be notified quickly and easily, giving loved ones peace of mind knowing you're safe.

Assisting in Decision Making

Your emergency contacts can be consulted to help make important decisions in times of crisis, such as whether to undergo surgery or not.
