Browser Basics

A web browser is software that lets you view websites. It translates web code into pages you can read and interact with.

Chrome's Advantages

Chrome is fast, secure, and syncs across devices. It has a clean design and powerful features.

Installing Chrome

Download Chrome from google.com/chrome. Follow the simple setup process. It takes just minutes to install.

The Chrome Window Learning the Layout



Address Bar (Omnibox)

Type website addresses or search terms here. This all-in-one bar makes browsing simple.



Tabs

Open multiple websites in one window. Click the plus (+) to add new tabs.



Navigation Controls

Use back, forward, and refresh buttons to move between pages.



Menu Icon

Access settings, history, and tools through the three-dot menu.

Searching the Web



Type in the Address Bar


Enter your search words in the top bar. No need to visit Google first.

Chrome shows search ideas as you type. Click one to save time.

Try Voice Search


Click the microphone icon. Speak your search terms clearly.

Browsing Websites



Navigate with Links

Blue or underlined text usually links to other pages. Click them to explore.



Scroll to See More

Use your mouse wheel, keyboard arrows, or touchscreen to move up and down.



Adjust Size


Press Ctrl and + to make text bigger. Use Ctrl and - to shrink it.



Print Pages

Click the menu (three dots) and select Print. Preview before printing.

Tabs and Windows



New Tab

Click the plus (+) at the top of your window to open a new tab.



New Window

Press Ctrl+N to open a fresh Chrome window separate from your current one.



Pin Important Tabs

Right-click a tab and select "Pin" to keep it small and always available.



Incognito Mode

Press Ctrl+Shift+N for private browsing that won't save your history.



Bookmarks

Saving Your Favorite Sites



Create a Bookmark

Click the star icon in the address bar when visiting a site you want to save.



Organize Bookmarks

Create folders to group similar sites. Drag bookmarks between folders.




Access Bookmarks

Click the menu, then "Bookmarks" to see your saved sites.



Use Bookmarks Bar

Keep favorites visible by saving them to the bookmarks bar under the address bar.



Downloads and Files




Start Download

Click download links or right-click images and select "Save image as".

Manage Files

Remove downloads from your list by clicking the "X" beside them.




Find Files

Click the menu, then "Downloads" to see your downloaded items.

Check Safety

Chrome warns about dangerous downloads. Only download from trusted sites.

Managing Your Settings



Using Chrome with a Google Account

1

Sign In

Click the profile icon in the top-right corner. Enter your Google account details.

2

Access Anywhere

Your bookmarks, history and passwords sync to all your devices.

3

Multiple Accounts

Switch between work and personal profiles with different bookmarks and settings.



Chrome Extensions



What Are Extensions?

Add-on tools that enhance Chrome with new features



Find Extensions

Visit the Chrome Web Store through the menu



Install Carefully

Only add extensions from trusted developers

For beginners, we recommend starting with just a few helpful extensions like ad blockers or note-taking tools. You can always add more as you become more comfortable with Chrome.

Staying Safe Online

Check for Security

Look for a padlock icon in the address bar. This means the site is secure.



Block Pop-ups

Chrome blocks most annoying pop-ups automatically.



Clear History


Press Ctrl+H to view history. Click "Clear browsing data" to remove it.



Manage Cookies

Control which sites can store information about your visit.





Troubleshooting Common Problems

Chrome is slow

Close unused tabs. Clear cache in **Settings > Privacy and Security**.

Page not found

Check your internet connection. Verify the web address is correct.

Chrome crashes

Update Chrome. Restart your computer if problems persist.

Reset Chrome

Go to **Settings > Advanced > Reset settings** as a last resort.
